Minutes – Wednesday, June 9, and Friday, June 10, 2021

The Electoral Board of Amelia County met on **Wednesday, June 9<sup>th</sup>** in the Registrar's office. The meeting was called to order by Chairman Williams at 10:04 AM. Minutes of the May 11, 2021 meeting were approved as presented. Registrar Hathorn stated that there were no budget issues and that all expenses for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2021 will be submitted before the end of the month.

We then moved to the Canvas. There were no provisional ballots. We made note of minor deficiencies in the completion of paperwork and other minor administrative oversights by the precincts. These issues will be addressed with the Chiefs of their respective precinct. Canvas was completed at 11:33 AM. Registrar Hathorn shared a letter addressed to her from the ACDC Chair, Lauren Whittington. She expressed concern over the lack of advertising for the June Primary Election. She also expressed concern regarding a couple of interactions she had with Officers of Elections she spoke with at the polls. We decided we would address the concerns appropriately and send her a letter in response to her concerns. We will reconvene on Friday, June 11<sup>th</sup> at 3:00 PM.

The Board reconvened on **Friday, June 11<sup>th</sup> at 3:30 PM** to review any Absentee ballots arriving from the post office since Tuesday, June 8<sup>th</sup> – There were none. Additionally, there were no Provisional ballots to review. With the canvas process completed, we signed and certified the election results. There were 76 In-person voters, 37 by Mail ballots and 110 CAPS total votes. Six (6) voters used the Drop box.

The next Board meeting is scheduled for Tuesday, July 13<sup>th</sup> at 11:00 AM.

There being no further business to discuss, the meeting was adjourned at 4:15 PM.
